



COVID-19 Update

Effective July 1, 2020

NOTE: This does not include Stockhoff Memorial Nursing Home. The mandated visitor restrictions are still in place and use of face masks continues to be mandatory, according to CMS and MO Dept of Health & Senior Services.

Visitation

- Patients receiving inpatient/swingbed care may now have one patient representative per room.
- Patients receiving outpatient procedures may be accompanied by one patient representative.
- Emergency department patients may be accompanied by one patient representative.
- Pediatric patients under the age of 18 may have two designated visitors on the inpatient units.
- Out of an abundance of caution, patients who have tested positive for COVID-19, as well as those with pending test results, may not have a patient representative at this time.
- MMC Clinic patients may be accompanied by one patient representative.
- All patient representatives/visitors must be ages 16 and up.

Campus guidelines

- All individuals entering Madison Medical Center buildings will be asked the health screening questions for symptoms upon arrival. Patients and patient representatives are encouraged to wear face masks, especially if feeling ill. Patients with known exposure/symptoms of COVID-19 will be required to wear face masks. Patients are asked to please bring their own mask if possible. In addition, patients and their representatives should always be practicing proper hand hygiene.
- Social distancing measures should be observed when using waiting areas, registration areas, etc.
- Individuals are asked not to congregate in groups in common areas.
- Madison Medical Center will be continuing to maintain rigorous cleaning protocols in all areas during the COVID pandemic
